Surah Yasin, Verse 78

He makes likenesses of Us and forgets his own creation, saying, 'Who will give life to bones when they are decayed?'

"...and forgets his own creation", a person can examine his own creation; the molecular structure, the vacuole, the mitochondria, he can analyze everything. Without examining his own creation, in an ignorant manner, they say, "'Who will give life to bones when they are decayed?".

Surah Yasin, Verse 79

Say 'He Who made them in the first place will bring them back to life. He has total knowledge of each created thing;
