

“boundless Creationism” And “atlas Of Creation.”



On 8 and 9 February, 2007, the personal, evolution-based web site Le blog des bactéries et de l'évolution carried two reports titled "Boundless Creationism" and "Atlas of Creation." These contained the following statements:

If we think of a country or a culture that stands for the creationist movement, USA springs immediately to mind... According to a survey carried out in 33 developed countries, USA has the lowest number of adults who believe in the theory of evolution, but if we include Turkey it goes straight to the head of the list. This gilt-edged document shows that the heart of Creationism has gone not to America but to far further away.
