Adnan Oktar fut présenté comme suit :

Incontestablement, il [Harun Yahya] est le personnage non-politique le plus influent dans son pays et parmi les savants les plus importants dans le monde islamique.

Adnan Oktar : Le darwinisme affronte deux grandes difficultés, les fossiles et ses incapacités d'expliquer comment la première cellule est apparue. Darwin lui-même savait que les fossiles nient sa théorie, il a dit dans son livre *L'origine des espèces* que les archives fossiles ne peuvent pas être expliquées dans le sens de l'évolution...

Allah est Celui Qui a le pouvoir illimité, Qui n'a pas de faiblesse ou carence. **C'est pour cette raison, qu'Allah n'a pas besoin de causes, d'instruments, ou bien des étapes intermédiaires pour créer. Le fait que toutes choses dans le monde dépendent de causes naturelles et des lois de la nature ne doit tromper personne.** Allah, notre Créateur, est très haut de toutes ces choses. Certaines personnes qui ne réussissent pas à apprécier la puissance créatrice sublime d'Allah et Ses chefs-d'œuvres en ce qui concerne la création ont inventé des idées extraordinaires comme "l'évolution islamique". Quand ces gens qui affirment que les êtres humains ont subi un processus d'évolution sont interrogés "comment les anges et les jinnés sont créés ?", ils répondent "Allah les a créés du néant".

La manière dont le bâton du Prophète Moïse (psl) a été transformé en serpent avec un système digestif lorsqu'il l'a lancé, ne peut pas être expliquée en termes de l'évolution... De même, la façon dont un morceau d'argile en forme d'oiseau s'est transformé en un oiseau vivant et s'est envolé quand le Prophète Jésus (psl) souffla sur lui ne peut être expliquée en termes de l'évolution. Ni d'ailleurs la résurrection le Jour du Jugement. Les jardins et les demeures du paradis ne peuvent être expliqués par l'évolution non plus.

Darwin himself also knew that the fossil record repudiated his theory. He admits in his Origin of Species that the fossil record cannot be explained in terms of evolution, argues Harun Yahya.</p> <p><i>[An interview with Harun Yahya by Kourouh Ziabar]</i></p> <p>Inarguably, he is the most influential non-political figure of his country and among the most significant scholars of the Islamic world. The heading-making, best-selling, controversial intellectual whose sumptuous "Atlas of Creation" sold 10,000 copies worldwide is described by Le Monde as the "Global Leader of Muslim Creationism" and La Liberation comments that his anti-Darwinist notions have "caused total panic in a single move."</p> <p>Adnan Oktar, writing under the pen name of Harun Yahya, is a 1956-born Turkish scholar of interdisciplinary studies and his 216 books on creationism, evolution, Islamic unity, oriental culture and political Islam have been embraced by readers in some 150 countries in more than 40 languages.</p> <p>He is the Honorary President of the Turkey-based Science Research Foundation which sponsors the publication of his profuse books and features on the prominent radio and TV stations, newspapers and websites regularly.</p> <p>In September 2008, he rigorously won a bid against the renowned British Professor Richard Dawkins by having the Istanbul's 3rd 2nd Criminal Court of Peace ban the website of renowned Darwinist on the grounds that he had insulted the personality of Mr. Yahya with defamatory and blasphemous comments.</p> <p>In an interview with me, Harun Yahya describes that why he is opposed to Darwinism so fervently: "Darwinism faces two great predicaments, the fossil record and its inability to account for how the first living cell appeared," he describes. "Darwin himself also knew that the fossil record repudiated his theory. He admits in his Origin of Species that the fossil record cannot be explained in terms of evolution."</p> <p>He denies the notion of natural selection as the supremacy and diffusion of favorable hereditary traits in a successive reproduction of generations and asserts: "One of Darwinism's most important tactics is to use complex terminology sprinkled with incomprehensible Latin words, to pass over what they cannot explain away and generally to muddy the waters and attempt to show that what is impossible might actually have happened!" he adds. "It is pointless for a theory that cannot account for how the first cell came into being to speculate on how living species appeared. In addition, natural selection has no features capable of giving rise to a new species, and that is a clear and technical reality."</p> <p>Harun Yahya does not believe in the sequence of human's evolution which was followed by the metamorphosis of apes into human being and denounces it as a devious and false argument: "As well as all the universe and all living things, human beings also came into existence by God commanding them to Be!" he stresses. "No life form is descended from any other human beings were created as human beings and have no common ancestors with apes or any other creatures."</p> <p>Yahya believes that Darwin's thesis that humans and apes share a common ancestor was not supported by any scientific findings either when it was first proposed or subsequently."</p> <p>He had previously called for his readiness to mount a live debate with Richard Dawkins before the TV cameras, but the British ethnologist who had branded Yahya's Atlas of Creation as "imposturous", refused and wrote in his personal blog that he prefers "not to give publicity" to creationists, even if they think that "we have not the courage" to participate in debate with them.</p> <p>Harun Yahya intriguingly believes that renowned dictators of the world believed in Darwinism as the theoretical basis of their atrocities and felonies: "If a theory makes a scientific claim and insists on imposing that on the entire world, despite having been disproved with hundreds of pieces of evidence by all branches of science, and if efforts are made to keep it alive in the face of reason and science, then there is clearly nothing at all in any way related to science going on here."</p> <p>"I realized right from my high school days that all this bloodshed, these world wars, the ruthless exploitation of people and revolutions could not be spontaneous, but that there had to be something behind them," believes Yahya.</p> <p>"When I researched it, I saw that all these scourges were organized by Freemasonry, and that the religion of hypocrisy is Darwinism. There is no materialism without Darwinism, and no communism, fascism, savage capitalism or sense without materialism!" he adds.</p> <p>"Those responsible for the great wars in the 19th and 20th centuries, all the slaughter, invasions and genocide then, were all Darwinists: Hitler, Stalin, Mussolini, Lenin, Mao and all the others believed in and espoused Darwinism, and Darwinism always lay at the heart of the blood they shed and the suffering they inflicted" concludes Yahya.</p> <p>Harun Yahya, belonging to a noble lineage of Ottoman Empire, has been engaged in intellectual activities and struggles since his early school years.
